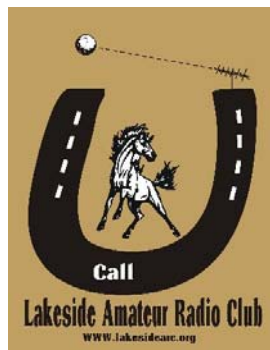
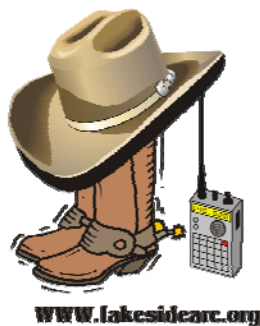


WHY YOU SHOULD CHOOSE LAKESIDE AMATEUR RADIO CLUB
